The Elmbridge Natural History Society was originally founded as the Weybridge Natural History and Aquarist Society by Miss.E.Mills in 1951. The aim of the Society is to provide opportunities for those who wish to enjoy and increase their knowledge of natural history in general and around Elmbridge in particular..

Indoor meetings are held from October until April, on the second Wednesday of the month, at 8:15 pm., at the Methodist Church Hall, Mayfield Road, Weybridge. These may take the form of illustrated talks, covering a variety of natural history and environmental themes or, at a couple of the meetings, feature items from members.

Field meetings are held mainly in the warmer months and usually include a bird-watching session, summer study walks to look at flowers, trees and dragonflies, an autumn fungus foray and occasional moth evenings when a mercury vapour lamp is used to attract subjects for study.

The society has a web site and a quarterly bulletin is produced to which members are encouraged to contribute.
